

Buzzy Bee Craft

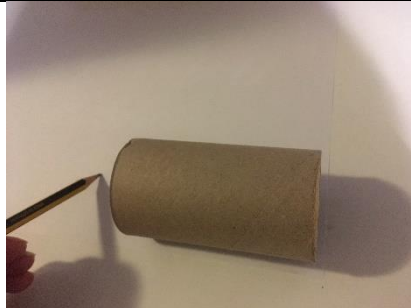
You will need:

- A toilet roll tube
- Plain paper
- A pencil
- A yellow crayon
- A black crayon
- A ruler
- Greaseproof paper
- Cardboard - such as a cereal box
- Glue or tape
- Scissors



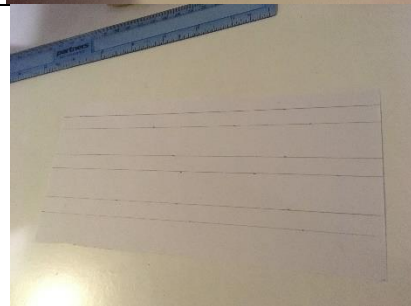
Step 1:

Using the tube as a guide, measure out a piece of paper that will cover the tube. Cut out the piece of paper.



Step 2:

Using a ruler if you have one, draw stripes along the paper. Make alternate stripes twice the width - for example one 2cm, then 1cm, then 2cm again. Make sure you draw these horizontally, along the long edge of the paper!



Step 3:

Colour in the stripes, using the yellow and black crayons. Make the wider stripes yellow and the thinner stripes black.



Step 4:

Carefully glue or tape the paper onto the cardboard tube. This is the body of the bee!



Step 5:

Use the end of the tube as a guide to draw a circle onto paper. You will need to make this slightly bigger than the end of the tube.



Step 6:

Stick the piece of paper onto some cardboard. Cut the card circle out. Draw a face onto the paper side and colour it in.



Step 7:

Using glue or tape, stick the face onto the end of the tube. You may need to gently press it in place for a minute or two before you let go.



Step 7:

Make the bee's antennae by measuring two small pieces of paper to half the length of the tube. Cut these out so that they are rectangular with a blob on the end - like the shape of a match. Colour these in black, on both sides.

**Step 8:**

Using glue or tape, stick the antennae to the back of the bee's head, so that they stick out over the top.

**Step 9:**

Make some wings by cutting out a rectangle with wavy edges, from some greaseproof paper.

**Step 10:**

Place some glue or tape down the centre of the rectangle - be careful to pick the side which will make the wings stick up and out. Stick it to your bee and he's ready to fly! If you have some string, you could add this to your bee and hang him up to decorate your room.
