

Cardboard Christmas Wreath

You will need:

- A cereal box
- A bowl
- A glass
- Plain paper
- A pen
- A pencil
- Colouring crayons
- Glue or tape
- Scissors
- String



Step 1:

Using a pen, carefully draw around a bowl onto the back of a cereal box. Cut out the circle.



Step 2:

To make the inner circle of the wreath, place a glass on to the middle of your cardboard circle and draw around it carefully with the pen. Cut this out.



Step 3:

Draw the shape of holly leaves onto a piece of paper. You will need several of these, so repeat the design. Cut these out and colour the leaves in green, and the berries in red.

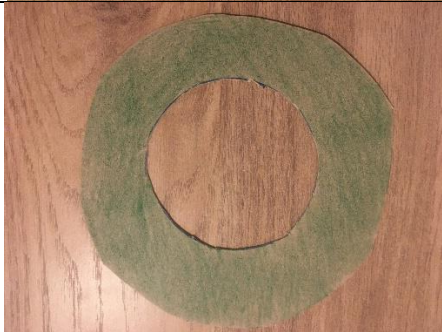


Step 4:

Draw the shape of ivy leaves onto a piece of paper. You will need several, so repeat the design or draw a few different types of design. Cut these out and colour them in dark green.

**Step 5:**

Colour in the base of the wreath using a green crayon.

**Step 6:**

Arrange your holly and ivy leaves around the wreath. Once you are happy with the design, stick the leaves down using glue or tape.

**Step 7:**

Using a pair of scissors, carefully make a hole at the top of your wreath. You might need a grown-up to help with this. Place a piece of string through the hole, and tie a knot so that it makes a loop.



Your wreath is now ready to hang up! It's the perfect thing to make your room feel festive.
